Stables and Yards:

There will be designated areas for the following:

- Day competitors
- Competitors with confirmed bookings of stables

- Competitors with confirmed bookings of yards
- Competitiors assembling their own yards

Local competitors within a 50km radius of Gatton will not be eligible for booking stables or yards unless there are any spare after the close of entries. You are eligible to camp and make your own yards in the designated areas.

Equestrian Queensland Gatton World Cup long sleeve Tee Shirts can be purchased for \$35 with your entries, please include your bank details for refunds of bonds and any appropriate fees.

Fees:

- Stabling must be included with your entries
- Stables \$20 per night per horse + \$25 bond will be charged per stable for duration of the show and refunded only if stable is left clean (119 stables available)
- Available 20-25 stables at the University of Queensland Gatton campus (approx. 6kms from showground), but camping is not allowed, same rate as above
- Yards \$15 per night per horse (including shavings) \$25 bond will be charged on your yards and refunded only
 if yards have been cleaned before departing and manure left outside the yard (40 yards available)
- Plenty of room to erect own yards + \$15 per yard for shavings if required. This must be organised with the Stable Coordinator Graham Sedger on arrival. \$25 bond will be charged for your yards and refunded only if yards have been cleaned before departing and manure left outside the yards in one pile.
- Camping \$15 per night per camp site for duration of show
- Ambulance \$5 per rider per day or \$12 per rider for duration of the show

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- All World Cup competitors must submit a rider profile with your entry.
- All ENTRIES, STABLING (BONDS) AND CAMPING must be lodged by midnight on 22 July 2012 at <u>www.globalentriesonline.com.au</u>

- Late Entries: will be accepted after 22 July 2012, but with a 50% late surcharge, please call to lodge entries.
- Stables may only be booked with entries with full payment.
- All riders must be financial members of the Equestrian Federation of Australia (EA) or a club affiliated with the Equestrian Federation of Australia
- Limit of 3 horses per rider per class and, 2 starts per horse per day excluding the Teckna Young Rider Class as there is no restriction on the number of horses ridden by one rider
- A horse can ONLY compete in one Championship class
- Junior Rider: from the beginning of the Calendar year in which they reach the age of 12, until the end of the Calendar year in which the reach the age of 18.
- Young Rider: from the beginning of the Calendar year in which they reach the age of 16, until the end of the Calendar year in which they reach of the age of 21.
- Draws will be posted for all Rings on a whiteboard in draw orders.
- Ring One will be by draw order ONLY.
- All presentations must be mounted (stallions may be substituted with another horse for presentations.)
- No electric fences allowed.
- Refunds: 50% refunds will be given on a presentation of a doctor's certificate or a veterinary certificate on the date of the class
- All riders and owners must be financial members of the EA to compete in official classes, and all horses competing in official classes must hold current EA registration and performance cards. Riders maybe required to present horse registration/performance cards upon request of the committee.
- DRESS: The Organising Committee strongly encourages all riders to be dressed according to the <u>FEI requirements</u> and those attired incorrectly will not be allowed to start.
- Australian helmet standards will apply
- All riders must wear riding boots and an approved helmet at all times while mounted
- The Organising Committee reserves the right at their absolute discretion to alter or amend any of the conditions, regulations, or any aspect of the event as they see fit.
- Swabbing: The Organising Committee reserves the right to swab horses. Random swabbing of horses may be conducted in any official class. Horses chosen for swabbing must proceed directly to the swabbing box immediately after the presentation.
- All dogs must be on leads and secured at all times. All dog faeces must be picked and put in appropriate bins, plastic bags and bins are situated around showground.
- All riders competing at the event will be expected to have read and accepted the Conditions of Entry, and the Disclaimer.

Any complaints or protests in any way related to the event, whether valid or not, will not be considered by the organising committee unless they are presented in writing and duly signed by a single clearly identified person. When the letter is being presented on behalf of a group it is that group's responsibility to nominate a person to sign it on their behalf. Whether any letter of complaint or protest is acted upon is at the sole discretion of the organising committee
